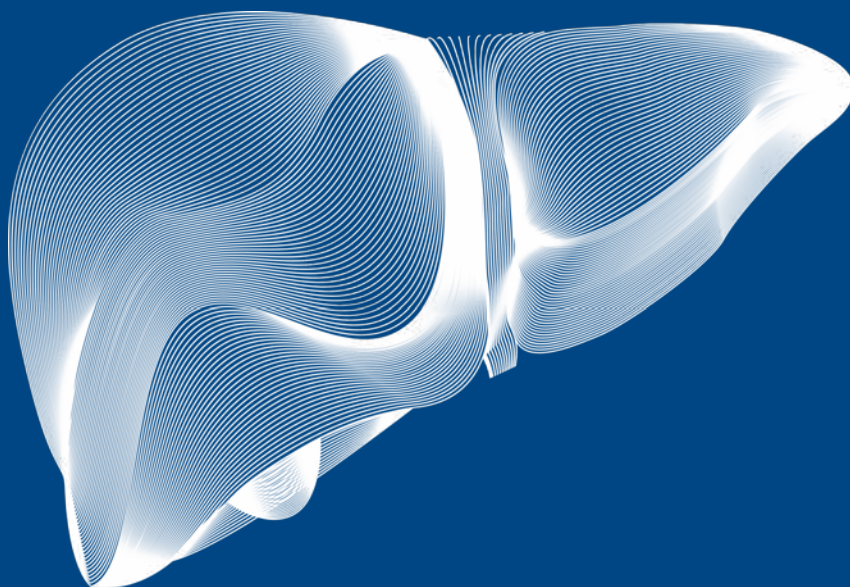

Meet-the-Experts sessions will be streamed live at the Track Hubs and online through the event app. Note that interaction will not be possible for online delegates.

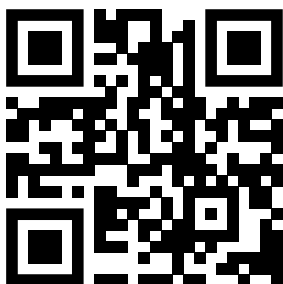
New at EASL Congress
