



Registration Terms and Conditions

Definitions

The EASL™ Congress 2026 is organised by the European Association for the Study of the Liver (EASL™).

These General Terms and Conditions shall manage your registration and participation to The EASL™ Congress 2026 and the use of our platform.

Congrex Switzerland Ltd is the registration system data processor of The EASL™ Congress 2026, 27-30 May on behalf of European Association for the Study of the Liver. The provider supports the congress secretariat and is responsible for registration services and is hereafter referred to as Congrex Switzerland Ltd.

Any enquiries or requests for additional information, modifications and cancellations are to be communicated to Congrex Switzerland Ltd by email.

Condition for registration

These General Terms and Conditions are valid for each attendee registered for The EASL™ Congress 2026, 27-30 May. Any registered person (physician, allied healthcare professional, student, media representative, speaker, exhibitor, etc...) is considered as an attendee. These General Terms and Conditions are also binding for all group registrations.

Registration fees deadlines

Early registrations will be accepted until 13 January 2026 – 23.59h CET.

Should your early registration remain unpaid on 13 January 2026 it will be upgraded to the late registration fee.

As of 14 January 2026 until 26 May 2026 - Midnight CEST, standard registration fees apply for every new registration.

As of Wednesday, 27 May 2026 until Saturday 30 May 2026 - Midnight CEST, last-minute registration fees apply for every new registration.

Modification & Cancellation

For cancellations received prior to **29 April 2026**, midnight CEST, deposits will be refunded less a **25% administrative charge**. After this deadline, no refund policy will be in effect.

A handling fee of 50 EUR per registration will be charged for every registration modification. Name changes are possible until 20 May 2026, midnight CEST, only.

If a delegate wishes to change their registration type (from onsite to online or vice versa):

1. From onsite to online: No handling fee will be charged. Please note that no refund will be issued.
2. From online to onsite: No handling fee will be charged. However, the fee difference—calculated based on the rates applicable at the time of the original registration—will be invoiced.

The General Payment Conditions apply.

After registration, you will receive personal access details to access the Congress platform. These access details are strictly personal and cannot be given to any other person.

Group Registration Procedure

As a travel agent, please make sure to only register the delegates with their individual email addresses.

To register your group, please log in / [create a profile here](#). If you cannot remember your password, please use the “forgot password” option. Once logged in, please click on the tab “**group registration**” and follow the 3 steps given online:

1. Order tickets (please make sure you choose the correct registration category for your delegates and keep in mind that some categories require proof uploads)
2. Add delegates (please only use the delegates’ individual email addresses)
3. Assign tickets

Group Data Management

Names of all participants must be submitted, and reservations assigned online by 24 April 2026, midnight CET.

The Group Leader hereby commits to manage group registrations using the tools proposed by the official registration bureau. The m-anage portal will be used to respect relevant registration deadlines.

Contact information is to be entered in the system including the full coordinates of the participant of the Congress. No generic agency coordinates will be accepted if reservations are handled by a third party or on the behalf of a sponsor. Reservations for Registration will then be assigned and updated through the m-anage portal and managed by the Group Leader or its internal representative.

Congrex Switzerland Ltd, as the Official Registration Bureau will not be responsible for entering contacts’ coordinates nor assigning services on behalf of the entity hereby engaged in this contract.

Should the Group Leader or the entity engaged in the present contract choose not to proceed with the proposed online tools, Congrex Switzerland Ltd will charge a handling fee of 40 EUR per participant, provided that the full coordinates are supplied.

General Payment Conditions

The registration will only be confirmed upon receipt of payment in full. Payments will be accepted in Euros by credit card, as well as by bank transfer (only available until 6 May 2026, midnight CEST).

A letter of confirmation/payment receipt will be sent by email once The EASL™ Congress 2026 Registration Team has received the fully completed registration form and the related payment. This letter of confirmation/payment receipt will act as a contract, and once issued, the above payment and cancellation conditions will apply.



VAT application:

- Registration fees **for onsite** will be shown including 21% Spanish VAT.
- Registration fees **for online** will be shown excluding the VAT of host country. For EU zone, VAT will be calculated and applied at the time of registration, in accordance with the participant's country of residence, as required by EU VAT regulations for digital services.

Methods of Payment:

Credit card: only Eurocard/MasterCard, Visa and American Express are accepted. Please note that the merchant name that will appear on your credit card statement will be "Congrex Switzerland Ltd."

A handling fee of 3% is applied to each booking.

Bank transfer: Bank account details will be mentioned on your registration invoice (only available until 6 May 2026, midnight CEST).

Cheques: please note that payments by personal cheque are not accepted.

- i. it will provide EASL™, when so requested, with copies of relevant data protection laws or references to them of the country in which the [group leader] is established.
- j. it will respond to enquiries from data subjects and authorities concerning processing of personal data by EASL™.
- k. it will notify within 72 hours delay EASL™ of any actual, potential or alleged breach of the provision of this Clause.

Additionally, you acknowledge your agreement to comply with all the Terms and Conditions outlined for this Congress. In the event that a child accompanies their parent to the conference, it is essential that they remain under the direct supervision of their parents and do not venture beyond the designated registration area.

Force majeure and cancellation

EASL™ and Congrex Switzerland Ltd cannot be held liable by attendees for either the partial or total non-execution of these T&C or because the Event cannot be held due to events beyond the control of EASL™ and MCL (force majeure) or in the event of accident, an act caused by a third party, such as Acts of God including, without limitation to, credible threats of natural disaster in the geographic vicinity, war, curtailment or interruption of transportation facilities, threats or acts of terrorism or similar acts, pandemic, governmental travel advisory, a governmental elevation of the terrorism alert level, civil
